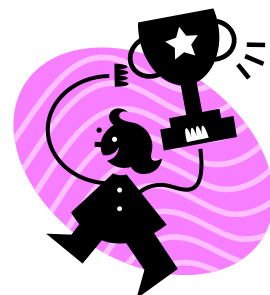
We do hope you will come along to support your child. We are so proud of our class assemblies and hope you enjoy coming to see your child just as much as they love to see you there.

We have a new KANO club starting soon for children in years 5 & 6. Children will learn how to assemble a computer from scratch, and learn basic coding skills. If your child has a place on a club you **WILL** receive a text message. You **WILL NOT** receive a text if your child does **NOT** have a place on a club. If your child was not successful this time you will be able to re-apply from week commencing 20<sup>th</sup> October 2014.
